ADVISING AT A GLANCE

What are the (*preparatory Course & GPA*) requirements for Man. Econ major?

— MAT 16A & B, ECN 1A & 1B, and STA 13 —

With a cumulative **2.8 GPA**

Why declare Man. Econ sooner rather than later?

- Some ARE Core and Restricted Electives are only open to students in the major during Pass one.
- Students must declare a major before they reach 90 units to avoid a registration hold.

Can I drop a course after the Oct 26 deadline?

- Yes, the Dean's Office will review student petition to drop a course beyond the drop deadline date. See Dean's Office in 150 Mrak Hall for more information.

Can I take ARE courses Pass/No-Pass?

- **No**, pass/no pass grading is not allowed for ARE Core and Restricted Electives.


When should I petition for a Man. Econ minor?

- Submit minor petitions during your final quarter of study at UC Davis.



STUDYING ABROAD WITH MAN ECON



For more information on studying abroad and the programs offered students should refer to the Education Abroad Center located at 207 Third St. Many Man. Econ majors have studied abroad in countries such as Australia, Egypt, France, Spain, Sweden, Thailand, and many more!

There are, however, some restrictions for the major that students should be aware of. Stu-



dents cannot take more than two restricted elective courses abroad. The major breadth, however, is not limited. As long as students find courses that match the subject areas listed in the breadth area it will count.
