To participate in the ceremony you must apply online at www.caes.ucdavis.edu/commencement.

NOTE: you must have 160 units by the end of Winter Quarter to be eligible.

*Walking in the ceremony does not mean you are officially graduated. Make sure you file for graduation online at <http://registrar.ucdavis.edu/graduation/>

- The Career fair is a great resource that could potentially help you land your first job. Below are a few tips and tricks, provided by the ICC, that will help you prepare yourself before the big day.
- **RESEARCH:** Go to icc.ucdavis.edu and check which companies will be attending. It is also good idea to research the company to see if you are interested.
- **REVIEW:** Review your resume and make sure that it is up to date and fix any grammar or formatting mistakes.
- **REHEARSE:** Practice running through your introduction a few times so that you can make an excellent first-impression on the potential employers.
